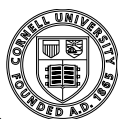

Timberframe, strawbale construction, Energy Star rated, compact design, daylighting, on-demand hot water, passive solar, solar cooling, strawbale construction, salvaged materials, lime-stabilized clay plasters, earthen floor, non-toxic finishes, local wood, Staber washer, Vestfrost (Conserve) refrigerator, Caroma double-flush toilets, Conserv fridge/freezer and other Energy Star appliances, compact fluorescent lighting throughout, kit yurt with earthen floor and woodshed with living roof also on property.

**Directions:** Rte 96N to Trumansburg. Left onto Rte 227 at Tburg post office. Go 1/2 mile, turn right onto Searsburg Rd. Ignore the house numbers. Go 1 1/4 mi. House is on the right just after Mount Rd. Please park in driveway or along Mount Road (Searsburg Road has a blind curve).
